


To prepare all trainee teachers to meet future education and life challenges in order to make positive contributions to the self and the society.

Students will:

- 1. Develop keen listening skills and strategies.
- 2. Speak more fluently (produce continuous speech with ease.
- 3. Speak more accurately through attention to the use of appropriate grammar, pronunciation and vocabulary.
- 4. Monitor their own accuracy and fluency, in and out of class.
- 5. Examine vocabulary, idioms and proverbs within relevant context.
- 6. Meet once a week with an instructor to discuss and prepare for the upcoming project.
- 7. Explore the content in greater depth through field trips and hands on practical experience.
- 8. Work in smaller groups to prepare a presentation of their project.
- 9. Produce a group presentation on their project.
- 10. Speak more fluently accurately in business situations such as small talk, interviewing, presenting and discussing case studies.
- 11. Improve their ability to write accurate, clear and organized compositions using a variety of sentence type.
